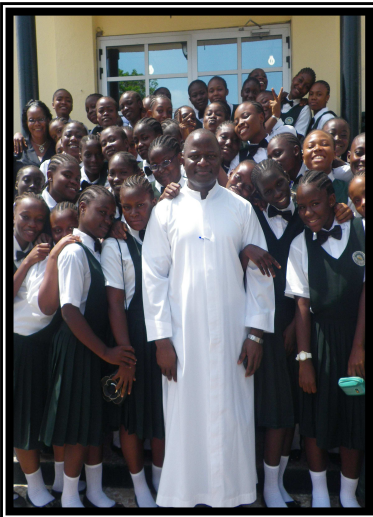


# PROJECT REPORT— FISCAL 2012

The Saints Friskies Alumni Association is proud to report projects undertaken during fiscal year 2012.

## TECHNOLOGICAL ENHANCEMENT PROJECT



FATHER VARFEE AND STC STUDENTS

During fiscal year 2012, the Saints Friskies Alumni Association (“SFAA”) undertook a project to help upgrade technology at STC by donating new and up-to-date computer, visual and video equipment.

Monies used to fund the project were raised earlier in 2012 at the STC Platinum Jubilee Celebration and national convention with the intent of repairing the elementary building roof. Before the funds could be disbursed, the Educational Secretariat of the Archdiocese of Monrovia notified SFAA that the cost to repair the roof had been covered by the Archdiocese, but urgently indicated the school was in dire need of technological and science laboratory equipment. In November 2012, SFAA Board of Directors approved the reallocation of the funds to purchase requested equipment.

The equipment was purchased and shipped in November 2012. Please see the next section, Collaborating with Textbooks Africa, for more information regarding the shipment of the equipment. The

Alumni Association’s president, Ms. Quallyna Porte hand delivered some

of the items to the Franciscan Missionary of Mary sisters at STC and the school administration during her personally funded December 2012 vacation. The remaining equipment was hand delivered in February 2013.

Ms. Emily Bestman, STC’s principal, confirmed receipt in the attached letter dated January 28, 2013.

STUDENTS DISTRIBUTING BOOKS

An alumnae (STC Class of 1985) notified Ms. Porte during the 2012 Convention of her ongoing project that would tremendously and directly benefit STC students. Wede Gibson has a 501c organization, Textbooks Africa, that collects and ships textbooks, library books and supplies to schoolchildren and teachers in Africa. During the discussion, she also indicated her organization could potentially need financial assistance with shipping the textbooks to Liberia.

Textbooks Africa collected more than 600 boxes of relevant text, reference and library books as well as tenderly used computers, dolls, and other

items for STC students. Textbooks Africa also hosted events to raise the necessary funds to assist with shipping but still required additional financial assistance.

In November 2012, the Board of Directors approved a donation of \$3,000 to Textbooks Africa that was used to supplement shipping costs. The Technological Enhancement Project equipment previously discussed were also included in the shipment. Delivery to the school was made in January 2013.

The Algebra Books were distributed among the Senior High Students. The distribution of books to the students of the Junior High and Elementary is going on. The other books are placed in the Library.


